

APPOINTMENT AND TERMS OF OFFICE OF GOVERNORS

The Chair of the Board of Governors

1. The Chair must be a serving member of the Board of Governors. The Chair is elected biennially for a maximum period of six years.

The Vice-Chair of the Board of Governors

2. The Vice-Chair of the Board of Governors must be a serving member of the Board of Governors. The Vice-Chair is elected biennially for a maximum period of six years.

Independent Governors

3. Independent Governors are elected by the Independent members of the Board of Governors, for a maximum tenure of three times three years.

Co-opted Governors

4. Co-opted Governors are elected by all members of the Board of Governors, for a maximum tenure of four times two years.

Staff Governors

5. Staff Governors are nominated by the Academic Board of the University, each for a maximum tenure of four times two years.

Student Governor

6. The members of the Students' Union elect their President annually.
